Bridge Painter – Journeyman

- 3 years of bridge painting or industrial painting, such as tanks, towers, or ships
- Experience in one or a combination of the following areas of expertise:
 - Abrasive blasting
 - Containment building
 - Spray painting
 - Operation / Maintenance of abrasive blasting machine, dust collector, large compressors
- Must be medically fit to wear a respirator
- Must be a member or be willing to join the Painters' Union
- Annual training consists of: the proper techniques for the collection, movement, storage, and disposal of hazardous waste into designated hazardous waste containers in accordance with RCRA specifications. Worker and site specific instruction for safely handling hazardous waste.
- Ability to sign off on a Hazardous Waste Inspection Sheet

Bridge Painter – Apprentice – Intermediate Levels

- Individuals with painting experience will be placed at a level commensurate with their experience.
- Must be medically fit to wear a respirator
- Must be willing to join and be accepted by the Painters' Union and their apprenticeship program, which requires a high school diploma or GED.
- Must pass the drug test required by the Union apprenticeship program
- Must be comfortable working above ground level
- Annual training consists of: the proper techniques for the collection, movement, storage, and disposal of hazardous waste in to designated hazardous waste containers in accordance with RCRA specifications. Worker and site specific instruction for safely handling hazardous waste.

Bridge Painter – Apprentice – Entry Level

- At least 1 year of construction experience, building, or road construction
- Must be medically fit to wear a respirator
- Must be willing to join and be accepted by the Painters' Union and their apprenticeship program, which requires a high school diploma or GED.
- Must pass the drug test required by the Union apprenticeship program
- Must be comfortable working above ground level
- Must be trained to contain, close, and seal hazardous waste containers for proper storage and disposal
